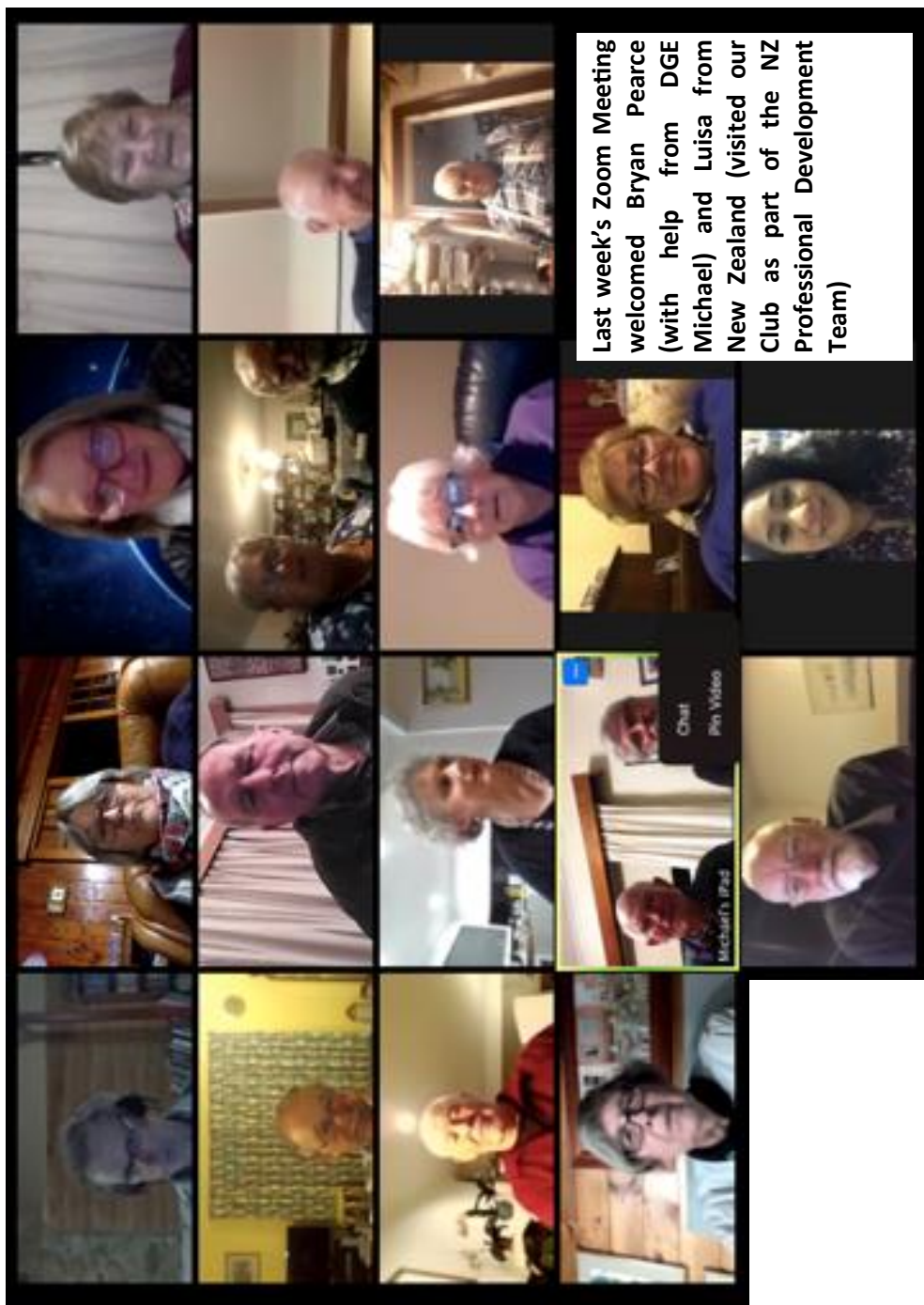
MEETINGS
